



Application Instructions

DEADLINE: April 15, 2010

All applications must be postmarked no later than April 15, 2010 to qualify for a scholarship in the 2010/2011 academic year. Late applications will not qualify. NO EXCEPTIONS.

Scholarships

The Scholarship Committee of the NYTHA is proud to announce that it is offering scholarship awards to backstretch employees and their direct dependents. The NYTHA provides the opportunity for qualified individuals to further their education at the college or university of their choice, either full-time or part-time. This scholarship is open to any field of study. At present, priority is given toward undergraduate degrees but graduate studies are considered.

Selection and Notification Process

Entries will be evaluated by the scholarship committee of the NYTHA. Scholarships will be awarded on the basis of merit, strength of written essay, quality of work submitted, academic record and financial need. Household income may not exceed \$85,000 per year to qualify. The Board reserves the right to review income and family financial records to establish an educational financial need. All applicants will be notified by mail in late July. The NYTHA will distribute scholarship monies directly to the institutions financial aid office, half in the fall of 2010 and half in the spring of 2011. A certification of enrollment is required from the recipient along with a written letter indicating where the funds should be sent.

Re-Application

All former NYTHA scholarship recipients must re-apply and submit a completed application form, transcripts, essay and all other required documents for their application to be considered for the 2010/2011 scholastic year. In addition, students must maintain a 2.0 G.P.A. in order to renew their scholarship.

Financial Information

All applicants if applicable must submit a copy of their completed Free Application for Federal Student Aid, Student Aid Report, Financial Aid Package and/or Financial Awards Letter. If current figures are not available at the time application is due, please submit the previous years' figures, and an estimated award expected for this year. This information can be obtained from the Financial Aid Officer. All information must be filled in to qualify the application.

Written Essay

All applicants are required to submit an essay, no more than 200 words stating his/her reason(s) for requesting this scholarship (attached to application.)

School Transcripts

You must include your most recent college or high school transcripts verifying your academic record. If the transcript is mailed separately, it must be received on or before May 15, 2010 to qualify for the NYTHA scholarship.

Interviews

Personal interviews are required for all new applicants.
